3. Product description

Product name: protective cardboard corners, corrugated board, solid board

Material: recycled cardboard and adhesive

Intended use: protective angle-shaped element for stabilising the edges of goods. It protects products against pressure and forces exerted by strapping and increases the stability of load units during transport and storage. Board provides protection against soiling.

4. Compliance with the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

Article 5 – Requirements for substances in packaging:

Packaging complies with the applicable legal requirements concerning the content of substances. It does not contain prohibited or restricted substances. The total concentration of heavy metals: lead (Pb), cadmium (Cd), mercury (Hg) and hexavalent chromium (Cr(VI)) is below the limit value of 100 mg/kg. Perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are not used during the production of packaging. Furthermore, the packaging is not intended to come into contact with food.

Article 6 – Recyclable packaging

Packaging consists mainly of paper-based materials and has been designed in such a way that it can be directed to paper recycling through existing collection, sorting and recycling systems. The materials used do not negatively affect recyclability.

Article 7 – Minimum recycled content in plastic packaging

Not applicable, as these are not plastic packaging.

Article 8 – Bio-based feedstock in plastic packaging

Not applicable, as plastic elements are not used as packaging material.

Article 9 – Compostable packaging

The packaging is not treated as compostable packaging within the meaning of the PPWR.

Article 10 – Packaging minimisation

Packaging has been designed in such a way that its weight and volume have been reduced to the technically necessary minimum, while maintaining the required functionality, safety and performance parameters.

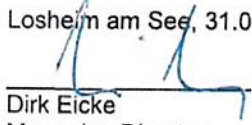
Article 11 – Reusable packaging

We declare the conformity of the packaging component indicated above **on the basis of technical data provided by the manufacturer** and assume responsibility for the formal preparation of this declaration.

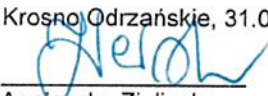
