3. Product description

Product name: wood-based HDF/MDF board (mainly raw, partly lacquered or foil-finished)

Material: defibrated wood bonded with resins and pressed under pressure

Intended use: use as spacer boards or protective boards in packaging, serving to protect the surfaces of finished goods

4. Compliance with the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

Article 5 – Requirements for substances in packaging:

The packaging component complies with the applicable legal requirements concerning the content of substances in packaging.

The sum of concentrations of lead (Pb), cadmium (Cd), mercury (Hg) and hexavalent chromium (Cr(VI)) does not exceed the limit value of 100 mg/kg, in accordance with Article 5 PPWR.

Perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are not used in the production of HDF/MDF boards. The packaging component is not intended to come into contact with food.

Article 6 – Recyclable packaging

After use, HDF/MDF boards may be subjected to material recycling or energy recovery. The materials used are generally recyclable.

Article 7 – Minimum recycled content in plastic packaging

Not applicable. HDF/MDF boards are not made of plastics.

Article 8 – Bio-based feedstock in plastic packaging

Not applicable. HDF/MDF boards are not made of plastics.

Article 9 – Compostable packaging

Not applicable.

Article 10 – Packaging minimisation

HDF/MDF boards are used in dimensions ensuring the required level of product protection while limiting the amount of material used to the necessary minimum.

Article 11 – Reusable packaging

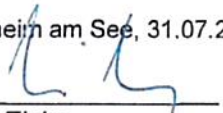

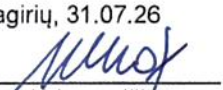
