3. Product description

Product name: Particleboard

Material: wood chips bonded with resins and pressed under pressure

Intended use: use as cover boards in packaging, stabilisation and protection of packed goods

4. Fulfilment of the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

Article 5 – Requirements for substances in packaging:

The packaging complies with the applicable legal requirements concerning the content of substances. It does not contain prohibited substances or substances subject to restrictions. The total concentration of heavy metals: lead (Pb), cadmium (Cd), mercury (Hg) and hexavalent chromium (Cr(VI)) is below the limit value of 100 mg/kg. Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are not used during the production of the packaging. In addition, the packaging is not intended to come into contact with food.

Article 6 – Recyclable packaging

After the end of use, particleboards may be reused or subjected to recycling or energy recovery. The material used is recyclable.

Article 7 – Minimum recycled content in plastic packaging

Not applicable, because particleboards are not made of plastics.

Article 8 – Bio-based feedstock in plastic packaging

Not applicable, because plastic packaging is not used.

Article 9 – Compostable packaging

Not applicable.

Article 10 – Packaging minimisation

The particleboards used have such dimensions as to ensure the required protection of the product and limit material consumption to the necessary level.

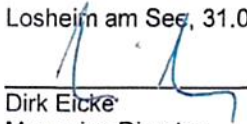
Article 11 – Reusable packaging

The packaging is not intended for repeated use as packaging material. After use, it is directed to the appropriate recovery process.

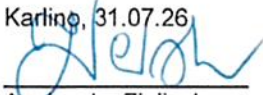
5. Responsibility

We declare the conformity of the above-mentioned packaging component **on the basis of technical data provided by the manufacturer** and assume responsibility for the formal preparation of this declaration.

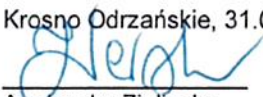

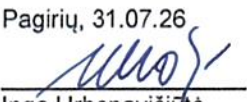
