Product name: Manual and machine stretch foil

Material: LDPE / LLDPE

Intended use: pallet stabilization, transport protection and protection of product surfaces

4. Compliance with applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

Article 5 – Requirements for substances present in packaging:

The packaging component meets the applicable legal requirements regarding the content of substances in packaging.

The sum of concentrations of lead (Pb), cadmium (Cd), mercury (Hg) and hexavalent chromium (Cr(VI)) does not exceed the limit value of **100 mg/kg**, in accordance with Art. 5 PPWR.

Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are not used in the production of the foil.

The packaging component is not intended to come into contact with food.

Article 6 – Recyclable packaging

The stretch foil has been designed in a manner enabling its recycling in accordance with PPWR requirements.

The materials used may be processed in existing collection, sorting and recycling systems, without adversely affecting the recycling process or the quality of the secondary raw materials obtained.

Article 7 – Minimum recycled content in plastic packaging

If the product contains recycled material, its share has been determined and documented in accordance with information provided by the manufacturer.

Article 8 – Bio-based feedstock in plastic packaging

Not applicable. The foil is not made from bio-based feedstock.

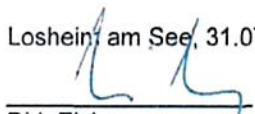

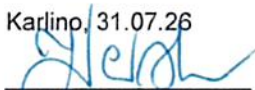

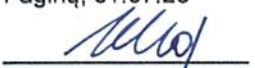
