Material: Wood

Intended use: use as reinforcing and supporting elements in packaging, serving to fasten and secure goods during transport

4. Compliance with applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

Article 5 – Requirements for substances present in packaging:

The packaging component meets the applicable legal requirements regarding the content of substances in packaging. 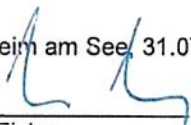

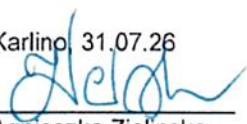

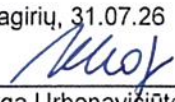
